1965 Ford Mustang GT



As usual, my wife wandered over to a first generation Mustang. She has always loved these cars. While she was looking at one, I spotted the Mustang for sale that we ended up making a deal on. I asked the owner about the car (was it 14,000 on the odometer or actually 140,000) but the dial was not off alignment? What was the engine since the GT badge was on the car? He stated that someone might have replaced the original motor with a 351 Windsor. He stated that he was the third owner and did not know much about the car's history. We purchased the car that next Tuesday and picked it up at his home on Thursday. Before we left, he asked if I would help him get the boxes of papers out of his basement that went with the car. Long story short when we got home that weekend I went thru the documents. It was originally ordered with that motor and the 14,000 was the actual miles. The former owner never looked at the papers. Calling on a friend of mine that lives and breathes Mustangs, he stated that only in 1965 and 66 did Ford allow the 351W to be installed in the Mustangs and they all carry the GT badge as the motor was the same that Ford was sending to Carrol Shelby for the Cobras. He believed that only around 150 cars were ordered with that engine in both years. The car now has 16,000 miles on it as my wife enjoys taking it to work on nice days.

Important Member information regarding the August 13 2017 Car Show

Set up for the show begins at 6:30 AM

Car Show Central is located in the shirt tent next to the registration tent and is staffed by Mark Oravetz and his crew. Direct anyone who has questions or needs assistance to Car Show Central.

If you need a work assignment or have finished your work shift, go to Car Show Central to record your hours worked. This is important as it affects your dues payment in January.

All workers should wear your red club work shirt. The red shirt identifies you as a WOCC member and is your meal ticket at the food tent. New members, your first red work tee shirt is free. Additional shirts can be purchased at Car Show Central tent for \$9.00.

Club members who work at the car show may purchase a car show tee shirts for \$9.00 each.

Members who bring their show car are asked to park on the asphalt.

Club members and band members must park their non-show vehicles in Fracaros Bowl parking lot or Waukesha Early Learning Center lot on west side of building.

Parking in the playground area of Frame Park is reserved for Handicapped parking. We attempt to keep a few spaces open for the public who wish to use the playground area of Frame Park.

The parking crew needs extra help in the morning when the show gates first open to direct cars into the correct areas. Otherwise people will attempt to park anywhere and waste parking spaces.






