1953 BUICK SPECIAL Model 48D OWNED BY MEL STARK

I found this car at a car show in Milwaukee in August of 2007. The odometer showed 58.068 miles which I believe to be original. The 2 door post is rather rare with only approximately 53,700 produced as most were 2 door hardtops. This car sold new for approximately \$2,000 which was considerably more than a Ford or Chevrolet. The 1953 Special was the last Buick to use the Fireball Straight 8. The Super and Roadmaster were already using the Nailhead V-8. I had the car repainted the car's original color as the paint on the hood and trunk was polished through. After acquiring the car, I replaced the points and condenser, coil, fuel pump and rebuilt the carburetor as a precaution. This car has the Dynaflow transmission which was used by Buick from 1947–1963. In 1953 the Dyna-flow transmission was redesigned which resulted in better efficiency, especially at highway speeds, and a higher level of performance and no penalty regarding the trademark smoothness. The car gets approximately 12 MPG in local driving. The engine runs so quiet that you can hardly hear it run. It is a very nice riding and a fun car to drive.

Committee Reports


Sunshine Committee: Judy Sodemann had no report. Jerry Kawatski reported that Tim Hunkins had heart surgery and is on the mend.


The department looks forward to attending future car shows and events hosted by the Club.


