MANUFACTURED: In 1980 at the AUBURN-CORD-DUESENBERG COMPANY (ACDC), in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma by ACD member Glenn Pray.

MODEL 866: Is a Modernized version of the AUBURN Model 851 and 852 Boattail Speedsters of 1935 and 1936 designed by Gordon Buehrig. Besides the art deco Boattail Speedster design, Gordon's other designs are the timeless CORD Models 810 and 812 and several DUESENGERG bodies in the 30's, often these models are referred to as "Rolling Sculpture".

VEHICLE HISTORY: The 866's were manufactured from 1968 to 1981 and our speedster is #94 of 113 built with less than 11K miles and having three previous owners. There were as many as 12 companies which copied the Glenn Pray 866 Boattail Speedster in the 70's and 80's. However, the ACDC factory build model 866 is recognized by the AUBURN-CORD-DUESENBERG CLUB as a true second generation AUBURN Boattail Speedster.

MODERN AMENITIES: Power steering and disc brakes, heater and defroster, air conditioning, LUCAS road lights, electric wipers, AMITY dual spotlights, tilt wheel, AM/FM radio with cassette.

CHASSIS: New 1979 LINCOLN chassis with 127" wheelbase, independent suspension with coil springs front and rear and a limited slip differential.

BODY: Full size fiberglass body formed from an original 851/852 speedster. The body is painted GM classic white with a golf bag door on the passenger side and a disappearing canvas top.

INTERIOR: Burgundy.

ENGINE: LINCOLN 460 cubic inch, 220 H.P. with functional side

exhaust pipes.

TRANSMISSION: C6 Automatic

WEIGHT: 3500 lbs.

Old Business



Meeting adjourned at 8:18pm.











