The board unanimously voted to approve Roberts as a supplier. The members in attendance voted unanimously to use Roberts as a vendor at the car show.
- Ron and Steve will meet with Roberts again to notify them that we decided to use them as our food vendor and work out all the details.

- The June meeting will be held at Bubba's Custard Stand, 1276 Capitol Dr., in Pewaukee on June 12th.







