

Knowing where the most important engine sensors are located, and the functions they perform can help you identify problems early.

Location \ Function

MAF	Mass Air Flow Sensor	Located right after the air filter in the intake air flow, Measures how much air is going into the engine to adjust fuel delivery.
MAP	Manifold Absolute Pressure Sensor	Located on the intake manifold with bolts or vacuum hose. Monitors manifold vacuum to calculate the load on the engine.
TPS	Throttle Position Sensor	Located on the throttle body, connected to the throttle shaft to monitor throttle opening angle.
02	Oxygen Sensors	Located in the exhaust system before and after the catalytic converter to measure amount of oxygen in the exhaust to fine tune the air fuel mixture to reduce emissions.
FCT	Engine Coolant Tempera-	Located on the block or cylinder head normally near the thermostat, monitors engine



Ron gave a Treasurer's report for the month of Mary. The report was accepted as presented.


Sunshine Committee




